

NEWBURYPORT YACHT CLUB ISLE OF SHOALS MOORING POLICY

Purpose

To allow for access and use of the Mooring for the enjoyment of our charter members. This mooring is marked 2287 MacIntosh and is located approximately N 42° 58' W 070° 36'

Policy

Member must be in Good Standing with the Club (Member's accounts must be paid in full.) The mooring is made available to charter members only.

Reservations

Reservations must be made for use of the mooring. The person making the reservation must be the person who uses the mooring. The reservation can be made with the NYC Dockmaster.

Harbormaster's Regulations and Ordinances:

- Because of weight and scope of mooring, no more than two (2) boats may be rafted overnight.
- In blows of 25 knots or more, only one (1) boat may remain and then only subject to dictates of the harbormaster.
- The Town of Rye and the EPA prohibit discharge of sewage into town waters. By using the mooring, you agree NOT to discharge sewage into town waters and to grant permission to the Harbormaster or his designated assistant(s) to board your vessel to inspect sanitation facilities (MSDs).
- Any non-compliance with the harbor ordinances is cause for revocation of the Club's mooring usage. This could result in fines and penalties for the violator levied by the club.

Charter Member shall be entitled use of the mooring as follows:

- The maximum number of days allowed for mooring use during a boating season is four (4) per member. The boating season is considered the period from May 15th to October 15.
- **The mooring cannot be used by the same boat on two (2) consecutive weekends or two consecutive days.**

Courtesy

- Arriving yachts intending to use Club mooring should hail moored yachts of their intention to use said mooring the following day.
- Moored yachts having to give way shall abandon mooring by 11:00 am.
- If member does not wish to raft, they must vacate the mooring for the newly arrived member.

Penalties

The penalty for not adhering to the Harbormaster Ordinances or NYC policies may cause loss of the Isle of Shoals mooring for the club and could result in disciplinary action by the Club.

Noncompliance with Club mooring rules will result in the following:

- First infraction, the privilege of mooring use is suspended for the rest of the season.
- Second infraction will result in a review by the Club's Board of Directors.

Additional Days

During the week, additional days can be approved by the Dockmaster.

Complaints

If anyone has a complaint about mooring use, they should communicate their concerns to the Dockmaster.
